

Jersey Village High School Registration Reminders
for
Incoming Freshmen (Class of 2023)
School Year 2019-2020

- Check page 17 in the Course Offerings and Description Guide (2019-2020) to review graduation requirements for the Class of 2023.
- Expect schedule changes due to leveling, scheduling conflicts or Master Schedule changes. Classes are leveled every semester. Once a class is leveled, we do not move a student back into the class they were leveled from.
- We do not take teacher requests for classes.
- Make good alternate elective choices, based on your Endorsement. You may be bumped out of some elective choices due to seniority and put into your 2nd or 3rd elective choice. **Choose wisely.**
- Carefully consider when to take your foreign language. It can be delayed but is required for graduation.
- Be aware that not all courses in the Course Description Guide are offered at Jersey Village High School.
- Make final schedule changes by the last day of 8th grade. The Master Schedule is created, and teachers are hired based on what you select. **NO** course changes in August.
- Substitutions for PE include: JROTC, Fall semester of marching band and color guard, and athletics. If a student withdraws from any of these classes, they will be moved to a regular PE class.
- Students may take Dance I for either Fine Arts or PE credit. A specific designation is required, and a form will be sent home for parent signature during the first 15 days of the course.

- Course Verification sheets will be sent home for finalization and parent approval.
 - If your child is planning to take K level classes, please look for the K after the class title. K level must be chosen, as it is not automatic, even if a student has always taken K level classes.
 - It is imperative that verification sheets be signed and returned, along with any other registration material sent home from the counselor. We use this to ensure students are taking the courses they have requested.
- Remember that 9th grade is a very important year. Future success does not happen by chance. Choose your classes carefully, study, attend tutoring sessions, pass your classes and earn your credits.
